## 'ETHNOMEDICINE: PROSPECTS AND CHALLENGES IN GLOBAL HEALTHCARE SCENARIO'

Ethnomedicine refers to the study of traditional & alternative methods of treatment involving the use of various natural resources, processes and healing practices. The practice of ethnomedicine is an age old complex multi-disciplinary system constituting the use of plants, minerals, animals and natural environment, which has been effective way of curing diseases and disorders. Ethnopharmacology or ethnopharmacy is an integral part of ethnomedicine, which is a related study of ethnic groups and their system medicine. The main onus of the system is integration of the traditional system of medicine and pharmaceuticals in consideration to human ailments.

Humans are distinguished based on various cultures and races, as well as the habitats they dwell in. The lifestyles and habits are many a time responsible as triggering factors for various diseases and disorders. Ethnomedicine thus takes into account all these factors considering the human body as one system. Ethnomedicine involves identification and Pharmacognostic study of the natural products, traditional method of preparation of dosage forms, bioassay of the TM, their clinical significance with relevance to the public health, and biosafety and re-evaluation of such drugs.

Ethnopharmacology also relates to pharmaco-epidemiology, the study of how drugs are used by and affect large number of people. When investigating & mimicking a natural product used by an ethnic group as a medicine, it is important that the methods of collection, extraction and preparation are the same or similar to those used by them. This is to ensure consistency and legitimacy of the experimentation.
